- If you haven't joined us yet, give WBC a try! You may enjoy the company more than the beer! :)





**April 15 Lemonade Joe or THE HORSE OPERA/Limonádový Joe aneb Koňská opera** 1964; 97 Minutes; G; subtitles; B/W; Comedy Satire; The movie is a 1964 [Czechoslovak acid western](#) comedy film, directed by [Oldřich Lipský](#) and written by [Jiří Brdečka](#), based on his novel and stage play. The film, a musical parody of old-time westerns, enjoys a near-iconic status in the Czech Republic as well as a considerable [cult following](#), and [Henry Fonda](#) was reportedly among its foreign admirers.

**May 20 Lidice-Fall of the Innocent** 2011; 121 Minutes; GP-violence; WWII massacre of the town of Lidice; Presented as a true story about the deputy [Reichsprotektor Reinhard Heydrich](#) who arrives in [Prague](#) as commander; two men from Lidice, one in jail and one who brags about his resistance fighting against the Germans which leads the Germans back to the town when Heydrich is assassinated in May.

After the May date, Friday Films will resume in the Fall.
