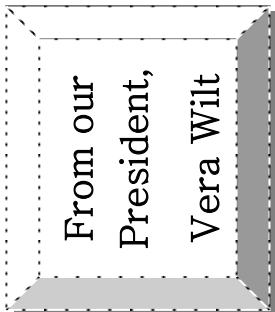

Dear Sokol Brothers and Sisters,

The Sokol Year is in full swing, with classes, social activities and fundraising.

First, I want to extend my personal, and the unit's deepest gratitude to the hardworking people who ran a successful **Rummage Sale** on October 9th and 10th. The Committee: Meribeth Tooke, Dorothy Becker, Lisa Kotynek, Chris Lanzel, Wendy Sanders, John Tooke and Elaine Zitko, report that this year's results were very good. Too many factors, however, have made it more difficult and frustrating every year to set up and run a successful event. Many of our members are probably not aware how much work there

still is at the end of a sale. The items worth saving for another sale had been packed and stored each year, while many other items were packed up and delivered to charitable organizations for resale or other use. Now that they have decided this was the last sale, everything has been so distributed, with just the "fine goods" that will still be available for sale at another Sokol Spirit event noted below, which will be held on November 21st. Whatever items are still left after that will also be donated to other organizations. The committee estimates that since these sales were established by Sokol Brookfield at least 35 years ago, nearly \$100,000 was raised for the unit.

Thank you the committee as well as to all who have made this fundraiser possible over the years, whether by planning the event, baking for the café, putting out the items, pricing, donating items, setting up tables, packing up the leftovers, sharing with other organizations, promoting the event, working during the sale, or even patronizing the sale and finding treasures. **Sokol Spirit is very grateful for all your hard work and dedication.**

There are other events coming up that are promoted in this newsletter, including **Spaghetti Dinner**, the **Wreath Sale**, **Falcon Key Club**, and a Vendor Fair.

The **Vendor Fair** is a new event this year, so let me explain what to expect. 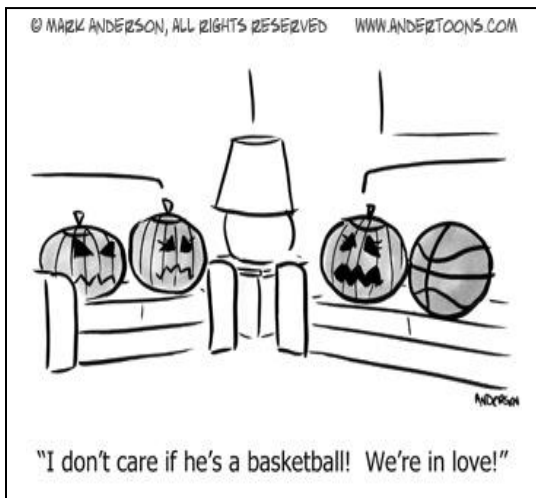

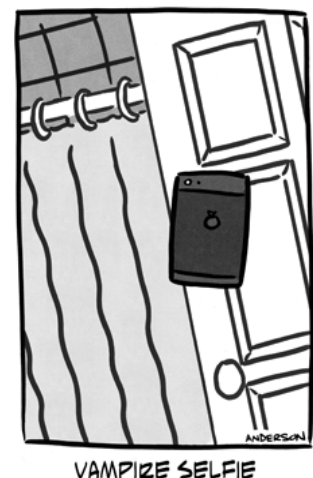
From the Youth Ambassador

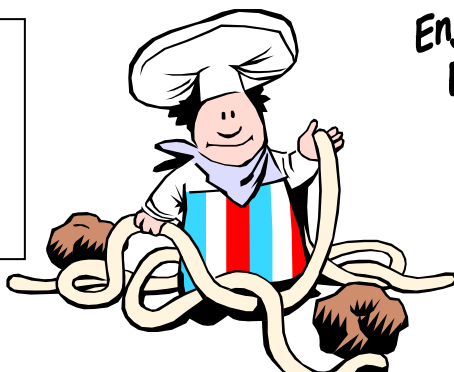

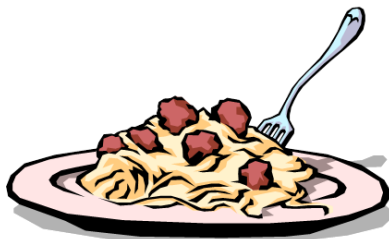

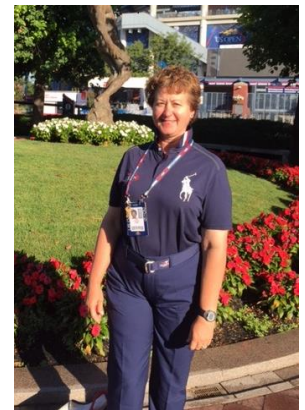
