I hope everyone is having an enjoyable

summer. Mine consisted of some European travel which of course included a week in Prague for the Sokol Slet. Another highlight occurred right here in our own nation's capital. On August 8th my

Grandfather who served in the Marine Corps during the Korean War participated in an Honor Flight to Washington DC. For those of you who are not familiar, Honor Flight Chicago is an organization that recognizes the bravery, determination and patriotism of our nation's war veterans. They are currently honoring WWII and Korean War veterans with a one day trip to Washington DC. I was lucky enough to accompany my Grandfather, Howard "Bud" Maskill, as his Family Guardian. The group consisted of 8 WWII and 82 Korean War veterans. They are escorted throughout the city to

monuments, memorials and museums, and are truly treated like heroes everywhere they go. Honor Flight Chicago is a great organization serving these most deserving heroes.

In many ways, I see similarities between HFC and Sokol. We are both non-profit organization, volunteer based and operate with American pride. Each flight takes more than 1,500 hours to plan, prepare and fly, and the majority of that time is executed by volunteers. I recall several of our own Sokol members have participated in past Honor Flights. If you are a war veteran who is eligible to participate or have a family member who may be interested, I highly recommend you look into it. I am grateful to have been part of such an amazing experience; one that I will never forget.



As our summer comes to an end and we prepare for the start of a new Sokol season, let's remember what makes Sokol what we are. As the American Sokol website states:

American Sokol is a multi-faceted organization guiding its members throughout life to physical and moral health, good citizenship and responsible patriotism, combined with continuous self-improvement. 


