

SPECIAL THEME for 2018-2019: We will recognize the 50th anniversary of "the Prague

Spring" (1968) a brief period of political liberalization in Czechoslovakia during the era of its domination by the Soviet Union after World War II; the Warsaw Pact invasion; and the phenomenon of the "Czech New Wave" or "Golden Era of Film". **The Czechoslovak New Wave** was a movement in cinema beginning in 1963 and lasting until the end of the Prague Spring reforms of 1968. We will feature key films from the period by the most prominent film makers of the era. Every showing is introduced by our head Czech language instructor, Pavlina Reicholova with questions at the conclusion! Film analysis available at each performance.
