- BMC is currently working on a solution for the roof repairs. We have four quotes from roofing companies.
- We are currently running on one boiler. The part alone costs \$750 to get the other one running. Also, we are looking to get testing done on the system and try to stop the leaks, and we are going to have to spend some money on flushing maintenance on the boilers.
- We are having the gym floor done in June.
