Termination of validity and exchange of CZK 100 to CZK 2000 banknotes with thin silvery thread

The CZK 100, CZK 200, CZK 500, CZK 1000 and CZK 2000 banknotes issued in 1995–1999 are invalid from 1 July 2022.

The invalid banknotes are most easily identified by the width of the silvery thread – a security feature which crosses the banknote vertically. The thread on the invalid banknotes is narrow and does not change colour when tilted, whereas the valid versions have a wider thread which changes colour from puce to green when tilted.

The versions also differ in terms of the year featured on the face side of the banknote and some other security features.

The exchange of invalid banknotes will be possible at the cash offices of all credit institutions providing cash services and at all seven CNB regional offices until 30 June 2024. From 1 July 2024, the exchange will be possible only at the CNB's cash offices for an unlimited period of time. Credit institutions providing cash services and the Czech National Bank must exchange invalid Czech banknotes free of charge, provided that they are sorted by denomination.





Sokol Spirit is taking a new approach to our Czech Language lessons. People are busy, and do not want to commit to many weeks of classes. Many travel or work long hours, and are not available for the full 8 or 10 week session. That makes it hard for everyone to progress in an orderly forward motion.

Adult learners really do not have time for homework, or sometimes even to review what they have learned to prepare for the next class. Czech grammar is hard, and you probably don't really want to learn all the rules...you just want to get by in communicating.

The old joke is: "How do you eat an elephant? - One bite at a time"

So here's our solution, via Zoom...since we all learned to use that thanks to Covid

New and Improved Zoom Conversational Czech Classes will be offered in short-term sessions, usually, one month at a time! We want you to learn and have fun.

We will also periodically announce a one evening or afternoon event focusing on a topic like: A Historical Event, Holiday Traditions, Artists and Musicians you should know, etc. Those events will be in person.

You sign up when you know you can make all the classes in 3 to 5 week groupings. Understand that no one will be fluent by taking weekly Czech lessons, but Czechs are very forgiving, and love it if you try to communicate in their languages. They already know it is a hard language.

Each session will focus on giving you the tools to communicate in certain situations, or for specific purposes. We will always announce the focus of the term, and we welcome your requests and suggestions so you get the most out of the experience.

For example, next Spring, we will offer one or two session courses to help you navigate travel to the Czech Republic. Travel Lessons will include essential words and phrases, cultural differences (i.e. what not to do), how to get around on public transportation, must see landmarks to plan your trip, etc.

The first Conversational Czech session will run October 4, 11, 18, and 25, 2023 at 7:00 PM via Zoom. This session will focus on general knowledge for getting started: pronunciation, basic vocabulary, days, months, numbers etc.
