

In the 17<sup>th</sup> Century religious schism occurred in Russia when Nikon was elected and reformed dogmas and rituals to unite Russian and Greek Orthodox churches...many challenged this as they felt it belittled traditions. Those that suffered were called Old Believers. Some relocated to China but were sent to Hong Kong, others to Australia, Brazil, Oregon and Alaska. The documentary follows a group some who fled to Turkey on the banks of the Danube Delta of modern day Romania. They fled from a land between Germany and Bohemia, Czech Republic

**February 16**, <u>Barefoot or Barefoot on Stalks</u>/<u>*Po strništi bos*</u>, 2017, 111 minutes, Subtitles, PG The film follows the young boy Eda Souček and his extended family during <u>World War II</u>. The family has to move to his family's home in the countryside home because Eda's father refuses to <u>*Heil*</u> in his job. Eda makes new friends and gets used to life in the village. He also meets his uncle who is known as Vlk. Vlk doesn't get along with rest of the family because he tried to strangle his mother. Eda eventually befriends Vlk. Life in the village is influenced by war. A prequel to <u>The Elementary School</u> shown September 5, 2014

March 15, <u>Zátopek</u>, 2021, 131 minutes, Subtitles, PG Athlete Ron Clarke competes at the <u>1968 Summer Olympics</u> but fails to win any medal. Feeling disappointed that he might have lost his last chance to win an Olympics medal he starts to doubt his career and decides to meet Emil Zátopek (Czech Olympian) whom he adores. The film is about their dialogue during which the audience can learn retrospectively about Zátopek's sports career and his life. A GREAT Sports film, many shots show athletes in Sokol uniform and stadiums like the Strahov where several Slets have been held.
