#### From our Education Director:

Each year, on October 8, we recognize Sokol Memorial Day, in solidarity with the Czech Sokol Organization. It honors the hundreds of Sokol members who were persecuted, imprisoned, and even killed by the Nazis in 1941 during World War II. On that date, the Gestapo made arrests of Sokols all across then Czechoslovakia because they considered Sokol a dangerous resistance group. Although the country had been occupied since 1939, in 1941 Reinhard Heydrich, the new governor of the "Protectorate of Bohemian and Moravia" was ruling with an iron fist, and he saw to the dissolution of the Sokol organization. Approximately 1,500 Sokols were arrested, ninety percent of those arrested that first night perished.

Today we know our organization as a social and fitness organization, but Sokols have been instrumental in the formation of a Czechoslovak nation in 1913, were early trainers of the Czechoslovak military, and have been a strong patriotic organization throughout history.

The Czech motto is "Truth Shall Prevail" and that is why our worldwide organization rose again and survives today.

Coming soon, we hope to introduce some informal educational gatherings on fun topics, including mush-rooming, baking, holiday traditions and much more. Look for more information in newsletters and on our website.

He didn't agree with the way the teachers used physical punishment and introduced the idea that a picture could help when reading a story. He wrote over 200 treatises and books. 


