

Sis. Anne Adam Svec, becoming an adult member of Sokol Slavsky in 1947 after years of children's and junior classes, was one of the most generous supporters of her unit. She worked tirelessly at every fund-raising function and participated in women's classes and exhibitions, including special numbers, as long as she was able. In later years, she also was a very willing chaperone on many Jr. class social functions, including local horseback rides, Wisconsin ski trips and Warren, Michigan dunes picnics, always having as much fun as the kids. Svec and Sons Funeral home was indeed the final "home" for many long-time Sokol members, who always, through Anne's services, made the family feel comforted. Anne, whether she took on the role of President of her children's PTA or leadership in countless community organizations, always made sure the goals were met, even if she had to silently "cover" for those unable to fulfill them. She was one grand lady and we all miss her irreplaceable dedication to Sokol as well as to community. Our deepest sympathy to her son, Jim, and daughter Sharon.

Bro. Jerry Zitko, our Sokol member since 1969, while never attending Sokol classes, was one of our favorite supporters and behind-the scenes worker at almost all the social functions we ran – his specialty (during the actual event) as bartender, which, of course, meant making sure our inventory was always well stocked. As a member of the Board of Directors, he served for many years as Sokol Spirit's leasing manager, donating countless hours to contract negotiations and tax and insurance management. And as a worker at Spirit's weekly games, the Bingo Ladies adored him, especially when their winning numbers were called. Jerry loved many pursuits, especially gardening, but his professional career revolved around the commercial printing industry, with customers such as Kraft Foods and Sears. He was the epitome of a great salesman. We miss his friendliness, his smile, his outgoing personality and extend deepest sympathy to Sis. Elaine and their children, Bro. Jerry R. and Sis Susan D'Andrea.


