SHAMROCK SHUFFLERS



OVEN LISTY — Recipe from Sis. Bessie Jandak

1/2 lb. oleo or butter

2 cups flour

• Combine with fork or other tool.

2 egg yolks

1/2 cup sour cream 1 teaspoon vanilla

- Combine and add to flour mixture.
- Mix with hands until it gathers together.
- Refrigerate 6 hours.
- Divide into four parts and roll thin.
- Cut into small rectangular pieces about 2x3" and cut a slit in the center of each piece.
- Bake at 360°F until lightly browned.
- Dust with powdered sugar when cooled. Enjoy!
