#### WORDS FROM OUR OUTGOING PRESIDENT

On June 5, 2010, Sokol Spirit held its Annual Meeting where major changes were made, including the election of officers and topics very important to the Sokol Spirit Unit, including a new dues structure.

At Sokol Spirit, we have to pay dues for every one of our members to (1) American Sokol, and (2) the Central District. At the ASO National Convention in April 2010, the delegates voted to collect ASO dues of \$40 per year for every member of the organization, (which includes a yearly \$5 convention fee). In addition, the Central District also collects dues at a rate of \$5 per year for every member. We at Sokol Spirit had a graduated dues structure with members with 60+ years of membership paying nothing as an honor to their long-term loyalty to Sokol Spirit. With over thirty members having 60+ years of membership, we found that Sokol Spirit was barely covering expenses to ASO and the Central District, and that did not help our own unit. Sokol Spirit values long-term members and their continued contribution to our unit, therefore, at the Annual Meeting, a proposal was voted on and accepted that dues starting in 2011 will be as follows:

- Dues for <u>all members</u> with 1-59 years of membership will be \$65 (this covers the ASO and Central District dues plus \$20 Sokol Spirit dues)
- Dues for members with 60+ years of membership will be \$45 (this will cover the ASO and Central District dues only—no Sokol Spirit dues)
- Dues for students and persons in the military will also be \$45

Sokol Spirit still considers members with 60+ years of membership as honorary, but we need help in paying ASO and Central District dues. We hope you understand. Our revenue from Bingo and other fundraising events has not kept pace with the increased cost of maintaining our building which, by the way, turned 80 years old last October.

In the past, ASO and Central District have charged units on a quarterly basis. At the Convention, ASO decided to collect all dues each year at the beginning of January. We at Sokol Spirit will therefore send out dues collection notices for the year 2011 in September of 2010 with the hope that we will have all monies collected by January 1. Since we do not want to cause any financial hardship on any member, please contact our financial secretary, Sis. Thank you to all for your support during the last year. For a variety of reasons, I decided not to run for re-election this year. As of June 5, 2010, your new president was elected and is Bro. Adam Wilt who, I have no doubt, will be a wonderful president to lead Sokol Spirit into the new decade. Please welcome him and give him your support as well.

Thank you, too, to the other officers, committee members, and delegates that are stepping down this year from their positions. You all did an awesome job and were greatly appreciated...even though you didn't think so at times. A special thank you to the Executive Board members who are "retiring" for only a short time, I hope: Bro. Ken Nagel, who as Men's Director kept the men's activities in good shape; Bro. John Bazata, who as 2nd Vice President kept everything in the gym running smoothly; Sis. Diana Rhoades who served so well as Educational Director; Sis Doris Barda who served as Sunshine Chair for many years and did make our lives brighter, and to Sis. Ellie Babka, who did an outstanding job as Membership Chairperson...Sokol Spirit is indebted to you all.

I wish you all a very happy summer vacation. Don't forget, registration for classes is September 10, 2010 at the gym. Come, join our classes—we have some new and exciting activities planned.
